FEAST OF EPIPHANY

6th and 7th JANUARY 2018

REFLECTIONS OF THE WEEK: Today the church celebrates the solemnity of Epiphany. Epiphany is a Greek word meaning “appearance or manifestation of something or a person. Here it means the appearance of God in the person of Jesus. This feast reminds us of the great event that took place at the Baptism of Jesus in Jordan by John. It is here that the voice from above proclaimed “You are my beloved Son”. Here the Father reveals who Jesus is. The western church associated this feast with the visit of the Magi. The Magi found Jesus in the Manger. It reminds us that God is in search of man. God came to man in the person of Jesus. Man is on his way to God. Since God came to man, man has to make his way to God. We need to remove all obstacles, difficulties and be ever vigilant to meet him. The Magi show us the way. Faith is God’s gift which reveals to us his salvific plan. The wise men labored hard and persisted in their search to find the new born baby. They saw the sign and said “Let us go and find him”. They followed the sign, the star and are awarded. He who experiences God’s presence becomes a new creation and he will follow the way of the Lord. It is our feast because God comes to us and we go to him. We will not find happiness in our homes, in our own narrow circles of family and friends. We have to go out of ourselves. Man must always be engaged in his quest till he realizes the ultimate goal of eternal life. When we come together for prayer and celebrate the Eucharist, He heals and strengthens us. The Epiphany takes place in our own person and in our community. Faith dares and fears not. So let us give ourselves as gifts and be united with him. With the Baptism of Jesus, that is tomorrow, we conclude the Christmas season and enter into the First Sunday in Ordinary Time of the Liturgical Year. (Pastor’s desk)
