PARISH NEWS: REFLECTIONS OF THE WEEK: LENT

Lent is the season in which we prepare for Easter. Lent has become a special time for fasting, abstinence, prayer, self-discipline and penance. It is the time to re-examine our priorities and leave sin and self-love behind and intensify our love and service of God and others. This conversion requires change both in our inner attitudes and outer actions. Every day we must make the hard choice to eliminate evil and bring good. The church teaches that all Catholics in good health to observe fasting and abstinence during Lent unless for some serious reasons they are unable to do so. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years old and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting means taking only one full meal. Abstinence forbids meat but not of eggs, milk products.

Lent is the favorable season for renewing our encounter with Christ who lives in his word, in the sacraments and in our neighbor. Lent comes to make its prophetic appeal to remind us that it is possible to create something new within ourselves and around us. Each day we can consider what we can do to follow Jesus more closely. LENT is the time to return to God. LENT is the time for prayer. LENT is the time for fasting. LENT is the time for generous giving. LENT is the time for combat. LENT is the time to say "No". LENT is the time to open our hearts. LENT is the time to turn away from sinful ways. LENT is the time to serve Christ's little ones. LENT is the time to die to self. LENT is the time to entrust yourself to God. LENT is the time to read God's word. LENT is the time to be with God. LENT is the time to come to Jesus. LENT is the time to receive the Holy Spirit. LENT is the time to be transformed from within. LENT is the time to be forgiven. LENT is the time to forsake worldliness. LENT is the time to look to the cross. LENT is the time to renounce evil. LENT is the time to carry your cross. LENT is the time for New life.

This year our Lenten Season begins with ASH WEDNESDAY on 14th February. We celebrate the EASTER Solemnity on 1st April. During this season of Lent, let us be more active in our spiritual life. On every Wednesday from 6.00 to 7.00 P.M we have Novena prayers to our Lady of Perpetual Help and adoration. On every Thursday from 6.00 P.M to 7.00 P.M. we have SCRIPTURE Study on Forgiveness. On every Friday in Lent, we have STATIONS OF THE CROSS at 6.30 P.M. in the church. So please try to come and pray together with your family.
