PALM SUNDAY– HOLY WEEK

24th & 25th MARCH 2018

Today, with the celebration of Palm Sunday, we enter into the HOLY WEEK. At the beginning of this Holy week, Jesus announces through the prophets the way he has chosen. This servant of God must suffer but God will not abandon him and helps him to overcome death. The readings exhort us to follow Christ, the humble servant of God. We have to die with him to follow him and enter into eternal life. Love for Christ renders suffering possible and meaningful. Jesus is our model and example in suffering.

In this Holy Week, we celebrate the EASTER TRIDUUM. These three days recall Jesus' Last Supper with his Apostles on Holy Thursday, His crucifixion and death on Good Friday, and his Resurrection of Holy Saturday night and Easter Sunday. In these three days we immerse ourselves to deepen our relationship with God.

HOLY THURSDAY: On this day the church celebrates Jesus' final meal with his disciples and the institution of the Holy Eucharist. On this day we recall how Jesus washed the feet of his disciples as a servant who came to serve. After the Mass, the consecrated bread is transferred into the chapel and kept it there for adoration.. We are reminded of the New Commandment of Love that Jesus gave.

GOOD FRIDAY: Good Friday is the only day in the year on which Mass is not celebrated. The altar is bare and the liturgy consists of proclaiming the passion story, intercessions, veneration of the Cross and receiving of Holy Communion. We meditate on the way of the cross at 3.00 P.M.. This is the day of fasting and abstinence also.

HOLY SATURDAY: The Easter Vigil re-enacts the passage from death to life. On this night we celebrate our deliverance by Christ our Passover and look forward to the day when we shall see him face to face. We have four parts in the liturgy of the night. 1.The lighting of the Easter candle 2.The Scripture readings resounding the story of our salvation 3. The initiation of the new converts and the renewal of our baptismal promises 4. The celebration of the Eucharist.

In this week let us reflect on the **SEVEN LAST WORDS of JESUS.**

1. Father forgive them for they do not know what they are doing
2. My God, My God why have you forsaken me
3. Truly I tell you that you will be with me today in paradise
4. Woman, here is your son. Here is your mother
5. I am thirsty
6. Father into your hands I commend my Spirit
7. It is finished.
