## **2<sup>nd</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER**

**7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2018**

Today we celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter, as the DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY. "Peace be with you. And with your Spirit". We repeat this greeting everyday during the Mass. What we really mean by this? Peace means joy and happiness all that is needed for human fulfillment. Peace is a greeting, a prayer, a command. In wishing peace, we express our concern for the other. It establishes relationships with the other. Peace is God's gift to men. Jesus, the "Prince of Peace" pronounced this as the very first word on appearing to his Apostles. Peace is the reality which brings us into the fullest relationship with God, with ourselves and with others. Many blessings are compacted in this one wish. When Jesus greeted the disciples with "peace be with you", a deep change took place in them. No more fear or anguish disturbed them, no more doubts and their hearts were filled with joy. While wishing them peace Jesus gave them another commission: "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive peoples' sins, they are forgiven". Jesus gave them a mission and a commission to continue his redeeming work of forgiving sins. For this, they need the guidance of the Holy Spirit and it is Jesus' greatest gift to them. It is a difficult task that Jesus entrusts to us. If we are the true followers of Christ, our life must be characterized by the forgiving Spirit. The more we go away from him, the more we become worldly and lose our peace. What prevents us from being peaceful is our own attachments, unnecessary worries and problems created by ourselves. Jesus knew the frailty of man and saw sin as the biggest obstacle to true peace. Jesus gave us a powerful weapon to destroy that enemy in the sacrament of Confession. When we wish during the Holy Mass "Peace be with you", let us really mean it. Let us wish one another every God-given good thing.

The DIVINE MERCY FEAST focuses the light of the Risen Christ into a radiant beam of merciful love and grace for the whole world. Sister Faustina of Poland had numerous visions during the 1930's. The message of the Divine Mercy is that God loves all of us. He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive his mercy and let it flow through us to others. God wants us to approach him in prayer constantly repeating of our sins and asking him to pour out his mercy on us. The more we trust in his mercy, the more we will receive.
