## **EASTER SUNDAY**

### **31st MARCH & 1<sup>st</sup> APRIL 2018**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Easter, the feast of Christian faith, the centre of the whole year of worship and the feast of all feasts. The feast day of Easter was originally a pagan celebration of renewal and rebirth. Celebrated in the early spring, it honored the pagan Saxon goddess Easter. The meaning of Easter is Jesus Christ's victory over death. His resurrection symbolizes the eternal life that is granted to all who believe in Him. The meaning of Easter also symbolizes the complete verification of all that Jesus preached and taught during His three-year ministry. However, His resurrection gave final proof that He was really the Son of God and that He had conquered death once and for all. Our faith, our hope and the meaning of Christian life is founded on the resurrection of Jesus. St. Paul says "If Christ has not risen from the dead, then our believing is useless". The resurrection of Jesus is the crowning point of the history of our salvation and the foundation of our Christian faith. On Easter, we celebrate that God's love overcomes even death. On Easter, we celebrate that goodness overcomes evil. Easter is the celebration of the resurrection of Jesus from the tomb on the third day after his crucifixion. Easter is the fulfilled prophecy of the Messiah who would be persecuted, die for our sins, and rise on the third day. (*Isaiah 53*). If Jesus had not risen from the dead, and if He had merely died and not been resurrected, He would have been considered just another teacher. However, His resurrection changed all that and gave final and irrefutable proof that He was really the Son of God and that He had conquered death. This is what makes Easter important even in the Catholic and Christian Calendar. According to the Old Testament, the priest would bring bulls, goats or a spotless lamb without any blemishes to be sacrificed as a sin offering for himself and for the people. It was believed that the blood of this animal would purify and make atonement for man's sins. However when Jesus came, He was a representation of the sacrificial lamb to take away the sins of the world. He was the final sacrifice. We no longer have to sacrifice animals to make atonement for our sins. Jesus has done this once and for all. It is the blood of the son of God himself that cleanses us from all sin. This is why Jesus is referred to as the 'Lamb of God'.
