God wants always to be with us. He is Immanuel that means "God with us". Sometimes it is difficult to understand the words of Jesus. What does he mean by the words "I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live forever"? First of all it is a promise. Jesus promises all who came to him, the food that God prepared for them, the living bread that came down from heaven. They can have this food only through faith. Through faith, Jesus becomes our bread of eternal life and we can have communion with him. That is why it is said "Everyone who believes has eternal life". Jesus becomes our spiritual nourishment in the Eucharist. The Jews could not understand it and many of us too cannot understand it. St. John wants us to know that Jesus is our food. Through him we have life in God. Without Jesus we are deprived of the gift of God's life in us. With Jesus we enjoy eternal life. God became man to call sinners and to save them. The Eucharist, the highest expression of Jesus' self-giving is an abiding gift for us. The Eucharistic table unites us with God and with the community. Once St. Francis of Assisi was attacked by the robbers. They not only used to rob but also kill people. He spoke to them kindly, brought them food and shared it with them. Then he invited them to the Friary for a meal. The hospitality, love and kindness they experienced changed their heart. They gave up their bad habits and began a new life. It started with a meal shared in love. The meal is a sign of friendship and love. In the Eucharist, Jesus invites us to the meal prepared by himself. It is the supreme expression of his love for us. When we eat this meal, we are transformed into what we consume. There are some people who stress so much their unworthiness to receive Jesus during communion because they are sinners or they did not yet go to confession. Canon Law of the church has instructed us that we should have a Eucharistic fast one hour before receiving the Holy Communion. This is not legalistic but rather we are made aware to receive communion with reverence, to prepare us mentally, to make us aware of the greatness of the event, to make us to have the right attitude and to have a loving disposition of a heart. To make our Mass complete: we should be punctual for Jesus invites us, we participate actively in the singing and praying, we dress properly, we genuflect or bow before the Blessed Sacrament upon entering or leaving the church. Let this Eucharistic meal make us one with the Lord and one another and let us thank him for this wonderful gift.
