## FIFTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME- C

9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2019

In the Gospel, Peter said to Jesus” Master, we worked hard all the night but without success”. Though Jesus knew very little about fishing he asked peter to go deeper into the sea for a catch. Against all his expectations, he caught more fish. Then he realizes his own sinfulness by saying” Lord, leave me, for I am a sinful man”. Peter is expressing his own unworthiness to follow Jesus. The Modern man in spite of the technical progress and scientific advancement suffers from more problems than ever which he himself has created. The fact that we call meetings and form committees for discussions and investigations shows how problematic our life has become. We all like to put things in order but in reality we talk too much and do little. Sometimes we have no faith in God or in others. And our discussions and meetings become mere substitutes for concrete actions. It is interesting to see this quote. “A meeting is a collection of individuals who individually can do nothing but who get together and collectively decide that nothing can be done”. We know that Peter was not an intellectual but he was open. He simply believed Jesus and acted according to his words. Peter left everything and followed Jesus. We understand from this that in order to follow Jesus one need not be an intellectual. One needs to know not tricks of the modern man. But one must be open to the promptings of the Spirit. Modern man has no patience, He calculates and plans and watches out for favourable circumstances to carry out his plans. But the case of Peter was different. He worked all the night, he was tired but still he was open, ready to obey Jesus’ words. This readiness to believe enabled him to experience the wonder of God. Sometimes we too may feel that our luck is down. In our disappointments and worries Jesus cheers us up. Jesus wins the confidence of the Apostles. We all need appreciation and concern for others, harmony in thought and action. Our life is full of surprises. Jesus invites us to enter into the new experience of God which only God can work out. He does not look at our sinfulness. Peter though he was a sinful man, was given the keys of the kingdom of heaven. It is not sin that keeps us away from God but the persistence in sin. Peter became a new person. The obedience to Christ’s command was rewarded by a huge catch of fish. Christ commands us strongly to put our trust in Him and to obey His commands. Sometimes that seems illogical to us and yet we must do. Peter, after working all night, was ready to give up, to surrender to failure. Though we try in our lives to accomplish certain things, and fail, we must never cease trying, we must never give up. Christ loves us all regardless of our past sins and offenses and wants us all to turn humbly to Him. God possesses absolute dominion over all of His creation and can work miracles. The fishermen are Teachers of the Church who catch us in the net of faith. Let us leave all things and like the Apostles follow Christ.
