SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

PARISH NEW

The Risen Lord greets the disciples "Peace be with you". It is a gift to be humbly accepted. When Jesus said to Thomas "Peace be with you", it entered into his heart and enlivened his faith. Thomas did not want to be a blind believer. Thomas had a chance of seeing and touching Jesus. We all have our doubts and questions. Thomas got his Christ-experience in the community of the disciples. The community should be a center of encounter. True faith demands total commitment, total determination. If faith is lost, life is turned into a naked struggle. Without faith, life is like a riddle without an answer, a night without a star and a journey without a goal. This Sunday is known as "Divine Mercy Sunday". Jesus revealed the image of Divine Mercy to St. Faustina in a vision that occurred in her convent on February 22, 1931. She wrote: "In the evening, when I was in my cell, I saw the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment, one hand was raised in the gesture of blessing, the other was touching the garment at the chest. From beneath the garment, slightly drawn aside at the chest, there were emanating two large rays, one red and the other pale. After a while Jesus said to me, 'Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in you'" (*Diary*-47). The image represents the risen Savior, who bestows peace upon men through the remission of sins, won at the cost of his Passion and death on the Cross. The rays of blood and water flowing from the Heart of Jesus pierced by the lance, as well as the scars of the wounds of his crucifixion, recall the events of Good Friday. Jesus spoke for the first time to Sr. Faustina about his desire to establish this feast in 1931. Jesus explained the reason he called for the establishment of the feast, saying: "Souls perish in spite of my bitter Passion. If they will not adore my mercy, they will perish for all eternity" (*Diary*, 965). One should prepare for the feast through a novena, or recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, beginning on Good Friday. Jesus said that on the day of the feast, "whoever approaches the Fount of life will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment" (*Diary*, 300). We've received countless testimonies from people who have experienced special graces through the Divine Mercy image. One grace that comes through the image is this: It heals the way people often mistakenly view God. People too often have a false image of God. They're afraid of Him and the Image of Divine Mercy helps to change that. In it, we discover our Merciful Savior who calls us to conversion but who also blesses us and loves us. Sacraments are the true sources and fountains of God's mercy. When we come together to celebrate the Eucharist, we become a community united in Christ. Our offering of bread and wine is transformed into the body and blood of Christ and we believe that Jesus is present in our midst. As a community, let us listen to his word and share his love and peace to build up our lives on the Risen Christ.
