THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

4th & 5th MAY 2019

In our everyday life we meet many people, friends and even those who do not like us. We exchange our thoughts and ideas. We work and live with them. Meeting people is part of our life and it has an influence on our life. It can change our life, enrich it and make it worth living. The more we understand others, the more they reveal themselves to us. Today's Gospel speaks of such a meeting. People meet Jesus but they failed to recognize him. Once they let him in, they experience a great change and great transformation. Life becomes more meaningful to them. It was for this that the early community often met together for breaking the bread and hearing the word of God. In this breaking of bread we recognize Jesus living among us. In the early Christian community we find an authentic way of living and sharing their material wealth. Many people after listening to the word of God changed their lives and it helped to build up communities to deepen their faith and strengthening their bond of love. Every day we come to celebrate the Holy Eucharist and to listen to the words of God addressed to each one personally. Meeting Christ never gets exhausted. It should be renewed and continued so that Christ becomes the center of our lives. Let us remember the words of Risen Jesus "I will be with you always till the end of times". We have the appearance of Jesus to his disciples on the shore of the sea of Tiberias. It was a turning point in the life of St. Peter. After the death of Jesus, they returned to their old profession of fishing. That night as fishermen they caught nothing. When Jesus asked them to cast net to the right side of the boat they could catch lot of fish. Then Peter underwent an interview with Jesus. Jesus asks him "Do you love me" and basing on his response Jesus said "Feed my lambs". Jesus did not ask what his gifts, talents and skills are. Jesus asks only one thing "Do you love me". Today Jesus asks us the same question. We must love Christ and his church. True love sets no conditions. Peter was given the care of the whole church, the flock of Christ. He has to feed the whole church by word and the sacraments. Peter and the other Apostles were forbidden to exercise their ministry of feeding the sheep. Time had come to Peter to follow Jesus Christ even to the point of death. Now the Church through the ordained ministers continues the same mission of Christ and Peter. Peter is called from being a fisherman into being the fisher of men. The net and the boat represent the church. Like the net, the church also can hold as many people as it can. Every minister is called to be a fisherman to invite people into the boat of the church. As fishermen we may fail but Christ is always present in his church so that the evangelization work of inviting new people into the church continues by the power of the Holy Spirit and the Resurrected Christ. Let all of us be nourished by the word and the sacraments so that we may have the living presence of Christ. FR. SUNDAR

Reporting abuse/pastoral response hotline

It is important all archdiocesan personnel – clergy, seminarians, religious, employees and volunteers – protect the rights of children and be alert to the possibility of child abuse. Under Oklahoma law, all individuals MUST report an incident or suspicion of sexual abuse of a minor (person under age 18) to civil authorities immediately. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services has established a statewide abuse reporting hotline (800) 522-3511. This number is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. If you feel a child is in immediate danger of harm call 9-1-1. In addition, the archdiocese provides an Abuse of Minors Pastoral Response Hotline for reporting the abuse of a minor (in the past or present) by a member of the clergy or other church personnel – (405) 720-9878. The archdiocesan victims' assistance coordinator, a licensed professional counselor, will respond. A report to the archdiocese does not relieve the individual of the duty to report child abuse to civil authorities as required by state law. In Oklahoma, failure to report child abuse is a misdemeanor punishable by law.
