PARISH NEWS

Today we celebrate the Ascension Sunday. After his resurrection Jesus appeared to his disciples for forty days and prepared them for their mission. At the Ascension, Jesus promised his disciples the Holy Spirit who would guide the church till he comes in glory. From the beginning Jesus, had his own glory. That celestial glory was temporarily hidden during his earthly life. When Jesus hung on the cross, he looked forward to the glorification of himself. Jesus was the first man to enter heaven with a glorified body. He who makes a pilgrimage to the Holy Land would not miss to visit the small mosque where according to the legend Jesus bade farewell to the Apostles and ascended into heaven. The location belongs to Muslims who even today show the pilgrims two footprints which Jesus left at his departure. Today we do not have access to any visible signs of the risen Lord but his words and sacraments. It is we ourselves have to become "footprints" of Jesus in this world as he wished. "You will be my witnesses till the end of the world". That means Jesus should be at work in us and through us. Jesus had completed his mission and it is we who have to convey the message of salvation now. Jesus said "I must return to my Father". We all have to return to our Father in the same way and that is our aspiration. We must look up to the real goal of our life and Jesus gives us the perfect example. The Ascension is the opening chapter of his new and more powerful presence in the church. He said and promised "I am with you always unto the end of the world". Jesus parted from his disciples only to be closer to them. The Ascension urges us to communicate to all that Jesus is the Lord of heaven and earth and he wants to save all. Ascension is a feast of hope that transforms and gives meaning to our life. Jesus, who had been taken up into heaven will come in the same way in his glory. This means that the church must accomplish the mission on earth with hope in the second coming of Christ. In the meantime we must be watchful and ready and do everything possible to prepare the world for his final coming. That is why Jesus before ascending said "Go into the whole world and proclaim the good news to all creation". Ascension reminds us also of two important things we should have in life, that is, to look up or to look up to God and to look down our eyes at people. Let us look up to God especially in making important decisions in our lives, to pray for his guidance on what to do with our lives. We should also learn to look down our eyes at people and be ready to help them. A saint said that when we are inside the church we closed our hands in prayer but when we go out from the church we open our hands to help other people. Jesus is no longer physically present to us but he is spiritually present in our midst. Christ is present when we celebrate the Eucharist. Christ was present when we were baptized. Christ is present when we are confirmed. Christ is present when a man and a woman exchange vows with each other. Christ is present when a priest is ordained. Christ is present when a sick person is anointed. That is why the Eucharist is called the Sacrament of real Presence. Every time we read the scriptures and when the lector reads the word of God, it is Christ who becomes present. Every time we gather to pray, the Lord is not only present in the Word or altar as Eucharist, the Lord is truly present in the community and becomes our guest of honor. Christ is present in a special way in the ordained minister. Let us remember what St. Bernard of Clairvoux said: "Service will not come without reward. But serving others will come without thought of any reward."
