## **PENTECOST SUNDAY**

**8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2019**

Today we celebrate the great event when Jesus filled his church with his Spirit and sent her to establish his kingdom on earth, the kingdom of love, joy, hope, peace and forgiveness. Today concludes the Easter season, the fifty days from Jesus' resurrection to Pentecost. On the day of Pentecost, the Spirit came down from heaven in the form of "divided tongues as of fire that rested on each of them. All of them began to speak in other languages. The Spirit brought *all* of them together in fellowship. To each he gives a gift and then gathers them all into unity. The same Spirit creates *diversity and unity*, and in this way forms a new, diverse and unified people: the *universal* Church. The Spirit makes the disciples *a new people* and he creates in the disciples *a new heart*. We need to avoid *two temptations*. The first temptation seeks *diversity without unity*. This happens when we want to separate, when we take sides and become locked into our own ideas and ways of doing things, perhaps even thinking that we are better than others. The result is diversity without unity. The opposite temptation is that of seeking *unity without diversity*. Here, everyone has to do everything together and in the same way, always thinking alike. So the prayer we make to the Holy Spirit is for the grace to accept responsibility for unity among all, to wipe out the gossip that sows the dandel of discord and the poison of envy. Now we come to the second new thing brought by the Spirit: *a new heart*. Jesus does not condemn them for having denied and abandoned him during his passion, but instead grants them the spirit of forgiveness. Forgiveness sets our hearts free and enables us to start afresh. Forgiveness gives hope; without forgiveness, the Church is not built up. Jesus stood in the midst of the Apostles and said "Peace be with you. He breathed on them and said Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive sins, they are forgiven". This is his special gift to the church. By saying these words, Jesus entrusts the Apostles with the mission received from the Father. As God sent him, he also sends them. They are called to continue the work of Jesus and save the people from their sins The Pentecost is the Birthday of the church. The church becomes missionary by receiving the Holy Spirit. No Christian is exempted from this missionary obligation. We all need the Holy Spirit because without it, we can do nothing. All through the centuries, the Spirit of God was at work among the Christian communities. It strengthened and kept them united. St. Paul tells that the Spirit is given to each person. Pentecost must become an event in our own life. When we say we truly believe in Jesus Christ, it means that the Holy Spirit is at work in us. It is the Holy Spirit that brings people together in one faith, one hope and one love, into the one body of Christ. St. Paul reminds us that we are the temples of the Holy Spirit and we must manifest the presence of the Spirit in our life. What role the Holy Spirit plays in our life? It cleanses and forgives our sins. It fills us with true joy and peace. It gives us light in times of darkness and gives us courage to witness to the Gospel. The Holy Spirit is not limited to time and space. The Holy Spirit is the fire of love burning in the Church and in our hearts even though we often cover him with the ash of our sins. Let us ask the "Spirit of God" to come down upon us anew, teach us unity, renew our hearts and teach us to love and forgive as God forgives us. Let us open ourselves and respond to the promptings of the Spirit and confess from our hearts that Jesus is our Savior and we believe in Him.
