## **CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY**

**22<sup>nd</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> JUNE 2019**

Today the church celebrates the solemnity of the most holy body and blood of Christ. It was a humble nun in Belgium, Saint Juliana (1258), who first suggested to have a special feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament on a day other than Maundy Thursday. She had a vision of the full moon appeared to her in brilliant light, while a part of its disc remained black and lightless. Christ showed her the meaning of this picture. The moon represented the ecclesiastical year; the black spot indicated the lack of a festival in honor of the Blessed Sacrament. She was to announce to the authorities of the Church that God wished such a feast to be established. In 1230 Juliana communicated her secret to a small group of learned theologians. A diocesan synod in 1246 decided to celebrate such a feast in the diocese of Liège. Pope Urban IV (1261-1265), on September 8, 1264, six years after Juliana's death, established for the whole Church that festival in honor of the Holy Eucharist and indulgences were granted to all who would receive Holy Communion or attend special devotions in addition to participating in Mass. Pope Urban IV commissioned the great Dominican scholar Saint Thomas Aquinas to compose the texts of Mass and Divine Office for the new feast. He also wrote the two most important songs for adoration "O SALUTARIS HOSTIA AND TANTUM ERGO". Whenever we have celebrations, let's say, birthday, wedding anniversary, it is always associated with food. We entertain our visitors by offering them food to eat. Whenever we want to thank people, we eat meal with them. In the same way, Jesus knew that soon He will leave his disciples and go back to His father and so He had a special meal with them. What He did on the first Holy Thursday was He gave a farewell meal to His followers and showed them how to celebrate the important part of the Mass. "We are what we eat". We cannot live without food. Jesus says the same about the Eucharist in the gospel of St. John: "If you do not eat the flesh of the Son of man, you will not have life in yourselves," (6:53). Catholic churches always have altars in them. The altar is the center of attention inside a Catholic Church. The altar is always built like a large table and all of us are gathered around it just as the disciples were gathered around Jesus at the Last Supper. We Catholics must remember that the main reason why we come to Mass on Sundays is not only to participate in Mass but to celebrate a Mass with Jesus. We go to Mass not only to hear the Word of God and the sermon of the priest but we want to go to Communion and receive Jesus in His body and blood. To come to Mass and not go to communion is like going to someone's house for a party and walking out just when the meal is being served. That is an insult to the people who invited us. Jesus said: "Anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood unworthily is guilty of condemnation." When the priest or the Deacon holds up the sacred host and says to you: "The Body of Christ," try to realize what you receive, that this sacred Host is the living Body of Jesus. It is the same Jesus who rose from the dead. In the Eucharist we have the foretaste of eternal life. We become sharers in the resurrection of Jesus. We are raised to the power and glory of the Risen Lord. In the Eucharist we experience the personal love and relationship of Jesus. Eucharist is the sign that makes all of us individuals as one loving community. Eucharist renews our covenant with God. This feast should strengthen our faith in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Let us not miss this profound experience of union with God that is offered to us through the Eucharist in every Mass.
