PARISH NEWS

When we are applying for a job, we present our best credentials. If we are owners of a certain company, we also want to make good proposals to the ones we want to hire. We say to them: "I will double your salary, I will give more benefits. After one year, you will be promoted". Jesus is different. In today's gospel, Jesus is asking and hiring men to become His disciples and missionaries of His word. Jesus tells them: "Come and follow me so that you will have a difficult life. When we apply for a job to Jesus Christ, we can say: "Make something good out of me." People crave for power. Jesus sends the seventy-two other disciples on a difficult mission to preach His word of salvation. They should not worry about the security of their life. If you want to follow Christ trust him, be the messenger of peace and love, never lose courage and fear nothing. He also calls each one of us to share in the task of evangelization whatever be our situation and status in life, whether we are parents, teachers, employees, employers, professionals or students. By virtue of our baptism and confirmation, we share in the mission of Christ to proclaim Him through the words of mouth and the deeds of our actions. There are innumerable opportunities open to the laity for the exercise of their apostolate of making the gospel known. Today Jesus says: "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few". Jesus sends the disciples out to do what is right, to love others, to proclaim the kingdom of God. Yet he is aware that they will not always be successful. He is aware that there will be people who reject their message and reject their love. He says, "Recognize the failure, then shake the dust from your feet and move on." We are not Gods. We will fail. St. Ignatius of Loyola says, "God does not demand success from us but only faithfulness." God demands to continue to preach the kingdom whether we succeed or fail. Jesus asks us not to close ourselves in our own comfortable worlds but rather to be ready to carry the joy of the Gospel to everyone we meet. We should bring peace into people's lives rather than turmoil and division. As disciples of Jesus we are being sent to share His values and promote His spirit of compassion, mercy and forgiveness both by what we say and by what we do. One of humankind's natural desire is to live a peaceful life. Peace which comes from God must be nurtured and preserved. *Peace* is a gift we must offer to our world. He invites us to be instruments to transform our world from the culture of war and hatred to a culture of peace. We can heal people from their emotional, psychological, spiritual and physical infirmities by our presence, prayer and even with a warm smile. It will not always be easy. Jesus warns the 72 that these gifts will not always be accepted. Jesus Himself experienced rejection by so many people of His own. Our fidelity, especially in the face of difficulties and struggles will ensure that "our names will be written in heaven". We can do the sowing but only God can ensure that the seeds take root and grow. Our church is a family just like our own individual family. Let us start preaching the Gospel in our families by leading exemplary Christian lives so that the spouses raise their children in the spirit of obedience and service, discipline them with forgiving love and teach them by persistent example to pray, love and help others by sharing their blessings. Let us strengthen our determination to share God's gifts with all those we meet and try to discover God's power in us and work for his kingdom.
