18th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

3rd & 4th AUGUST 2019

Today we are reminded that we are in a transitory world. Hence it is a call to make use of the things of this world prudently without losing our ultimate goal. It is only when we make heaven our goal that the full meaning of life would be realized. In our gospel today the rich man places a high value on material goods. We realize that some of these material things could be acquired through corruption. But let us remember that money and wealth are not everything. There are things that money cannot buy: true happiness and Kingdom of God which is our final destiny for this life. The Letter to the Hebrews says: "Stay away from the love of money, be satisfied with what you have for God has said: 'I will never fail you nor forsake you,'" (Heb 13:5). Money is just like drugs, we are addicted into it. There are people who have so much money in bank but they still long to become richer to the extent that they neglect their loved ones. Try to reflect on this: *Money can buy bed but not sleep. Money can buy books but not brain. Money can buy food but not appetite. Money can buy medicine but not health. Money can buy marriage but not love. Money can buy anything but not heaven.* All greedy people have one thing in common; they are pre-occupied with themselves of their own satisfaction without minding anyone else. Notice how the rich fool in the parable did with his money and wealth. He tore down his barns and built large ones to store all his grain to enjoy his life. It is good to have money and wealth because these can serve and help us to survive. **The first reading speaks about the meaning of life. According to him life is like a wind and nothing more. But life is worth living. It becomes rich and meaningful according to the way we live. Human calculations are always material and worldly. "What will a man gain if he wins the whole world and ruins his own life"? Watch and be on guard against avarice of any kind, for a man's life is not made secure by what he owns even when he has more than what he needs. The foolishness of the rich farmer was that he looked the security of his life in material wealth. He failed to realize in becoming rich before God. Material wealth should not stand on our way of going to God. Life becomes holy by holy living. Dying to self and living for others makes our life holy. Over anxiousness for security and clinging to material wealth makes us blind. Thus we become slaves of our own greed. We dig our own pit and bring punishment and destruction on ourselves. Still we can lead a happy life by making proper use of material goods. Today Jesus invites us to store treasures in heaven by leading a life pleasing to God. So let us seek the things that are above and not the things on earth.**
